FROM THE DESK OF FATHER MARK PAVLIK:



Dear Mary Queen of Peace Parishioners,

Thinking him the gardener....
 When I was in seminary at Mount St. Mary's in Emmitsburg, MD, we had a professor who used to like to work in the gardens around campus when he was not teaching. His favorite trick was to pop up out the garden from behind a shrub and startle seminarians who were walking back to the seminary building by shouting "Thinking him the gardener, she cried 'where have you put the Lord?!'" This was, of course a reference to St. Mary Magdalene, whose feast we celebrate on Wednesday. In the Gospel of John, we read about Mary going to Lord's tomb on Easter morning to weep, devastated by Jesus' passion and death. She is so overwhelmed with grief that when Jesus appears to her, she doesn't recognize that it is him, but thinks he is the gardener. It is not until Jesus calls her by name – "Mary" that she recognizes that it is the Lord whom she is encountering. With that realization, her tears stop and she is filled with joy at encountering the Risen Jesus. Whenever I hear it, this passage reminds me how easy it is to become so consumed with my daily concerns and worries that I can become unable to notice when the Lord acts. How often we are so focused on those things that seem to important that even if Jesus Himself were to stand before me, I might "think him the gardener" and continue on my path of worry and woe instead of allowing the Lord in to tell me the good news he has to share. The feast of Mary Magdalene reminds us to be ever diligent and ready to notice the Lord as he acts in our lives and not become so consumed with daily tasks that "thinking him the gardener," we miss the opportunity to encounter the risen Lord.

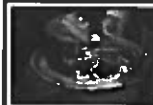
