FROM THE DESK OF FATHER MARK PAVLIK:



Be Careful What You Wish For

If God were to come to you and tell you that you had one wish – what would it be? A new car? A million dollars? A perfect body? King Solomon got that very opportunity in the first reading of this Sunday’s Mass. “Ask something of me and I will give it to you.” The possibilities are endless. God did not

put any stipulations on the wish. It didn’t have to be practical. It didn’t have to benefit others. It was a plain old “whatever you ask for, you will receive” offer. And of all the things in the world that Solomon could have asked for, he asked for an understanding heart “to judge your people and to distinguish right from wrong.” Solomon recognized that he was a mere youth and did not know how to act. He knew that riches and fame would fulfill a short-term need, but it wouldn’t make him a good leader. And that any treasures he had would be short lived and not improve what was important in his life on earth.

And now, thousands of years later, King Solomon is not known as being rich, but for being wise. There were plenty of people who were known for being rich, but many fewer who are known for being truly wise. And both kinds of people came to the same end – they both died. And you know what happened to all the riches of those famous rich people? Someone else has it.

This proves to be a little reminder to us what is most important in our world. Material possessions are, in themselves, not bad things. But they pale in comparison to what truly matters in the eyes of God and what will best benefit us on earth and in the eternal life to come. That’s why a regular prayer to the Holy Spirit for an abundant outpouring of the gift of Wisdom is a good idea. It is infinitely more handy in our day-to-day dealings with others and causes many fewer headaches that sometime accompany abundant riches. And most importantly, it keeps God in our plan and our focus on what will benefit us for our true home in heaven.
